The MKFU is a member of the World Karate Federation - WKF and the International Committee of the Mediterranean Games - ICMG

The Mediterranean Karate Federations' Union Championships provide the opportunity for participants to aim for Olympic values, strive for excellence and personal development. The UFMK/MKFU has the aim of promoting, organizing, regulating and popularizing the sport of the Karate in every Country of the Mediterranean basin, of protecting the physical and mental health of the Athletes, of contributing to the development of friendly relations among the National Federations and of defending the interests of Karate throughout the world.

7. OLBIA



The city of Olbia faces more than 20 islets of the Gulf and is protected by Mount Limbara. The natural beauty of these unspoilt places is rare. 17. OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

At registration, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants' main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be always worn during the event.

Only members of national federations recognized by WKF are admitted participating, following the registration procedures.

All participants must submit an official document (passport or other valid ID card) for the WKF identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of any competitor must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person bringing the athlete passport or other valid ID at the accreditation session.

The competitor who has not collected, either personally or through his/her coach the accreditation during the official registration, will not be included in the draw.

The official weighing will take place during the registration session.

Each national federation can register FOUR (4) athlete sand TWO (2) teams in each category.

Please note that all participants have to show their passports at the registration session.

- Registration is €30 per athlete per category and €60 for each team.
- €30 foreach referee participating in the referee seminar & exams.
- Succeeding to the referee exams will receive an MKFU badge which is €20 cost.
- Annual country membership fee is €300 and must be paid during the registration to MKFU treasurer.
- If changes are required during the official registration session, because of incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of € 20 is charged for each change.

EU and non-EU citizens (if entitled to assisted health care in EU countries) traveling in Italy with the required certificate (European Health Insurance Card or a provisional replacement certificate) may obtain services required directly, free of charge – excepting the payment of an eventual co-pay (called ticket)— at a public hospital or facility covered in private agreement with the National Health Service.

Non-EU citizens coming from countries not covered by the agreement are provided with health services that must be paid for in accordance with the relative scale of charges.

Italian's residents abroad. To Italian citizens, members of AIRE (Registry of Italians living abroad), having the status of emigrant and / or holding a social security pension paid by the Italian Welfare System, who return temporarily to Italy and have no insurance coverage, public or private, are granted, the emergency hospital services free of charge for a maximum period of 90 days per year.

25.2. Emergencies

In order to guarantee safe holidays to all the tourists all through the summer, all the emergency service of the Local Health Unit ULSS10, operating together with the 118-centre, is enforced with manpower.

S.U.E.M.: The Territorial Health Urgency and Emergency Service: it is active 24 hours a day and it is activated by dialing the emergency phone number 118. The call is free, even from mobile.

The operation center evaluates the gravity of the situation and, if it's necessary, takes action, in connection with hospitals and ambulancies.

25.3. Currency

Currency: The National Currency of ITALY is Euro (€)

Banks: All Banks offer currency Exchange and cash advances on major credit card.

Most banks open from 9:00 to 14:00 h on weekdays.

25.4. Electricity

Electricity Power: The plugs are in accordance with the European standard system of round pins. 220V/ 50Hz

25.5. Language

The official language of Italy is Italian. Organizers will also speak English.

25.6. Time

Time Zone: UTC +1

25.8. Insurance

In compliance with WKF Rules, it is obligatory for all the participants and members of the participating delegations have their own medical and personal trip insurance.

The Italian Karate Federation and the World Karate Federation as well as the Organizing Committee assume no liability or responsibility for the lack of insurance from participants and members of the delegations.

The head of the delegations must sign the enclosed terms of responsibility and return it by October 1st, 2024, the latest.
